

Note Taking: Quote Notes

- 1. Read your assigned selections thoroughly.**
- 2. Underline or highlight 2 to 3 significant quotes per page (use pencil if it's a textbook). Anything more is "significance inflation." Each quote should be no more than two sentences. Try to focus on the ideas that explain and support the key points of the reading.**
- 3. On a separate document, type out each quote.**
- 4. Underneath, explain *in your own words* what each quote means. Make sure you explain the quote in the context of the entire reading. Also, don't use quotes that simply repeat previous quotes.**
